Volunteers from the Chicago Conservation Corps (C3) will be holding a workshop to promote environmental awareness in the city of Chicago and beyond. The workshop is headed up by Michele Ritchie, a C3 trainee, and will include lectures by Jillian Phillips (C3 trainee), Zina Murray (Logan Square Kitchen), Rick Moskovitz (Plus Natural Enzymes). The lectures will include information about water conservation, ideas for "greening" your home and the benefits of using organic, non-toxic pesticides and cleaners.

Chicago Conservation Corps mission is to recruit, train and support a network of volunteers who work together to improve the quality of life in our city neighborhoods and schools through environmental service projects that protect our water, clean our air, restore our land and save energy.

In the workshop, 20 participants will create a "homemade green cleaning kit" comprised of 3 cleaning products produced from essential oils and non-toxic items you could find in your kitchen! Other recipes and tips for greening your home will be available to take home. All participants will receive a free environmentally friendly tote filled with "green gifts"! Refreshments and snacks will be served as provided by local Chicago businesses!
